Improve District Administration Build a Better Community




The Government announced the proposals on improving governance at the district level on May 2, 2023. Strengthening the District Governance Structure

The **Chief Secretary for Administration** and the **Deputy Chief Secretary for Administration** will personally lead and co-ordinate district affairs, so as to better respond to public views.





DCs with Diversity

People of different backgrounds, experiences and professions may enter DCs through appointments, District Committees and Geographical Constituencies elections, and as ex-officio members to **offer quality services to residents**. They can collect and reflect public views, allowing the Government to better gauge public sentiments and opinions.
