(1) 根據《鄉郊代表選舉活動指引》第四章,候選人須在發布選舉廣告後的**一個工作天內**,把與選舉廣告有關的資料/文件,包括准許或同意書的電子文件,上載至中央平台或候選人平台或向選舉主任繳存印本式文本,以供公眾查閱。

In accordance with Chapter 4 of the Guidelines on Election-related Activities in respect of the Rural Representative Election, the candidate should, **within 1 working day** after publication of an election advertisement, post an electronic copy of the relevant information/document, including permission or consent, onto the Central Platform or Candidate's Platform or deposit a hard copy with the Returning Officer for public inspection.
