A nomination in the specified form for the Village by-election for each of the above-mentioned Villages must be handed in by the nominated candidate **in person** (except where the Returning Officer, on application, allows another means of delivery) and received by the Returning Officer at the above address from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday and from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Saturday (except a general holiday), from 5 May 2011 to 18 May 2011, both days inclusive.

Specified forms of nomination may be obtained free of charge during business hours on any day other than a general holiday from the New Territories District Offices, or from the Home Affairs Department, 30th Floor, Southorn Centre, 130 Hennessy Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong.

If there is more than one validly nominated candidate for each of the above Villages, a poll will be held on 12 June 2011.
