Specified forms of nomination may be obtained free of charge during business hours on any day other than a general holiday from the New Territories District Offices, or from the Home Affairs Department, 30th Floor, Southorn Centre, 130 Hennessy Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong.

If there is more than one validly nominated candidate for each of the above Villages, a poll will be held on 15 December 2013.
