A nomination in the specified form of a candidate for each of the above Villages must be delivered by the nominated candidate **in person** (except where the Returning Officer, on application, allows another means of delivery) at the address of the Returning Officer stated above for the respective Village from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday and from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Saturday (except a general holiday), from 20 April 2016 to 3 May 2016, both days inclusive.

Specified forms of nomination may be obtained free of charge during ordinary business hours on any day other than a general holiday from the New Territories District Offices, or from the Home Affairs Department, 30th Floor, Southorn Centre, 130 Hennessy Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong.

If there is more than one validly nominated candidate for any of the above Villages, a poll for that Village will be held on 29 May 2016.
