Specified forms of nomination may be obtained free of charge during ordinary business hours on any day other than a general holiday from the offices of the Returning Officers at the above addresses, or from the Home Affairs Department at 30th Floor, Southorn Centre, 130 Hennessy Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong, or can be downloaded from the website of the Rural Representative Election (<https://www.had.gov.hk/rre>).

If there is more than one validly nominated candidate for any of the above Villages, a poll will be held for that Village on 16 June 2019.
