Notice of Objection

A person who considers that a registered person is not eligible to be registered as an elector or be registered in the division of an Existing Villages register in which that person's name and relevant particulars are recorded; or in the part or division of an Indigenous Villages and Composite Indigenous Villages register in which that person's name and relevant particulars are recorded; or in the division of a Market Towns register in which that person's name and relevant particulars are recorded; or in the division of a Market Towns register in which that person's name and relevant particulars are recorded, may, under section 23 of the Regulation, lodge <u>in person¹</u> at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer or the relevant Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (at the addresses listed above) <u>not later than 9</u> September 2014²(Monday to Friday : from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.; except Saturdays and general holidays) a notice of objection in the specified form.

Notice of Claim

A person whose principal residential address is in Hong Kong and who has made an application for registration but whose name is included in an omissions list or is not recorded in the provisional register or who has a claim regarding his/her particulars in the provisional register may, under sections 24 and 25 of the Regulation, lodge <u>in person</u>³ at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer or the relevant Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (at the addresses listed above) <u>not later than 9</u> September 2014⁴ (Monday to Friday : from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2

A person whose principal residential address is not in Hong Kong and who has made an application for registration but whose name is included in an omissions list or is not recorded in the provisional register or who has a claim regarding his/her particulars in the provisional register may, under sections 24 and 25 of the Regulation, lodge in person, by post (at the addresses listed above), facsimile transmission (fax number: (852)2591 6392), electronic means (email address : rre@had.gov.hk) (as an electronic record within the meaning of section 2(1) of the Electronic Transactions Ordinance (Cap. 553) authenticated by a digital signature within the meaning of that section), or authorize a person in writing to lodge on his/her behalf, a notice of claim in the specified form. The same must be delivered at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer or the relevant Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (at the addresses listed above) not later than 9 September 2014⁵ (Hong Kong time) (Monday to Friday : from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.; except Saturdays and general holidays).
