

Description of visuals:	Visual changes to a wide shot of a village in Clear Water Bay and a wide shot of Cheung Chau Island respectively. Super: 2019 Village Representative Election 2019 Kaifong Representative Election Voice-over says:
Voice-over:	For the 2019 Rural Ordinary Election
Description of visuals:	The scene switches to medium shot of Miss Myolie Wu, at a village in New Territories, holds a cardboard sign calling for registration Voice-over says:
Voice-over:	Eligible persons ...should register as electors by July 16
Description of visuals:	The scene switches to medium wide shot of a young man holds a cardboard sign calling for registration. The background is a village in Clear Water Bay. Voice-over:	Registered electors should apply by June 16
Description of visuals:	<p>The scene switches to a foreign young man in front of some village houses holding a cardboard sign of “更改登記資料” with the back of “Change of Particulars”</p> <p>Super: On or Before 16 June 2018</p> <p>Voice-over says:</p>
Voice-over:	Resident or Kaifong Representative electors should submit address proof
Description of visuals:	<p>The scene switches to an elderly woman in a salted shrimp paste factory in Tai O holding a cardboard sign of “Change of Particulars”.</p> <p>Then cut to a young couple in front of some village houses in Sai Kung. They are holding cardboard sign of “Change of Principle Residential Address” and “Submit Address Proof” each.</p>

Voice-over:	for change of principal residential address
Description of visuals:	<p>The scene changes to a medium shot of a truck with sign of “搬屋 Moving” leaves a village and cut to the truck stops in front of a few blocks of high-rise multi-storey residential buildings in town.</p> <p>Voice-over says:</p>
Voice-over:	People who have moved out of a village or market town are no longer eligible to be electors. They commit an offence if they vote.
