Provision of vocational training and trade testing to the ethnic minorities

by the CITA

1. Introduction

The statutory functions of CITA include providing training courses for the construction industry, and assessing the standard of skills of construction workers.

2. Vocational Training

- Currently the CITA is offering three main categories of training courses, 2.1 namely:
 - (i) the One-year / Two-year Full-time Basic Craft Courses for Form 3 school-leavers and the Construction Supervisor Trainee / Technician Training Programme for Form 5 graduates;
 - (ii) Full-time Adult Short Courses; and
 - (iii) Part-time Courses.

Since the majority of the frontline personnel of the construction industry communicate in Cantonese, plus the fact that most of the CITA instructors are veteran tradesmen from the industry and do not speak English, the medium of instruction has been Cantonese and the course handouts are also written in Chinese.

- With the growing demand from the ethnic minorities, arrangements were 2.2 made in 2003 and 2004 respectively for two groups of Nepalese to attend training courses at CITA on a trial basis with the aid of interpreters. However, the outcomes were found to be not satisfactory.
- Since then the CITA has been exploring the possibility of offering some of its 2.3 courses in English. Due to constraints in terms of resources, the two categories of full-time courses i.e. (i) and (ii) mentioned in 2.1 above will not be offered in English. However, CITA has made special arrangements for 14 Part-time Day-release or Part-time Evening courses (Appendix 1) to be conducted in English on a needs basis. These include some safetyrelated courses and certification courses for construction plant operators.

2.4 Amongst the above 14 courses, the Part-time Day-release Certification Course would be more suitable for the ethnic minorities. Both certification courses for gondola workers and builder's lift operators last for 2 days and there is no specific admission requirements. Certificate holders will need to attend the corresponding one-day revalidation courses upon expiration of their certificates which are valid for 5 years.

3. Trade Testing

At present, the CITA conducts a total of 50 trade tests for skilled craftsmen and 26 intermediate trade tests for semi-skilled workers. Amongst them, 15 trade tests and 18 intermediate trade tests (Appendix 2) can be conducted in English on request.

4. Conclusion

In response to demands and requests from the ethnic minorities, the CITA has been and will endeavour to develop or arrange more training courses and trade tests in English subject to the availability of appropriate English-speaking instructors and invigilators, and that it would be cost effective to do so. On the other hand, the Authority considers it is prudent that the community should pay heed to the fact that as the common language used on construction sites is Cantonese, workers who do not apprehend some working Cantonese in the work environment may be in hazard due to communication gap on construction sites during unexpected events.
