



## *Chapter 23: Local and International Telephone Calls and Internet Access*

The major operators providing local fixed line and international telephone services include Hong Kong Broadband Network Limited, HGC Global Communications Limited as well as PCCW-HKT Telephone Limited and Hong Kong Telecommunications (HKT) Limited. In addition, there are many international telephone service providers providing international calling card services. The major operators providing mobile voice and data services are China Mobile Hong Kong Company Limited, Hong Kong Telecommunications (HKT) Limited, Hutchison Telephone Company Limited (i.e. 3HK) and SmarTone Mobile Communications Limited.

You can make local or international calls from fixed line phones at home or business premises and from payphones at various locations, e.g. on the street and at the airport. You can also make and receive calls and access to the Internet almost everywhere in Hong Kong using mobile services provided by local mobile operators.

### **Local calls**

Fixed line telephone service is provided at a flat monthly charge per line with unlimited usage. In other words, no fee is charged for individual local voice calls. The cost of making a local call from payphone is HK\$1 for every 5 minutes. For mobile voice services, pre-paid SIM cards offered by local mobile operators are commonly available in their retail shops and convenience stores. These SIM cards, which require real-name registration before service activation<sup>1</sup>, can be suitably used with handsets compliant with 3G, 4G, or 5G standard.

For both fixed line and mobile services, calls to emergency service (**999 for**

**fixed service; 999 or 112 for mobile service**) and directory enquiries<sup>2</sup> (**1081** for English speakers; **1083** for Cantonese speakers; **1088** for Putonghua speakers) are free.

## Internet access

You can access to the Internet conveniently using mobile data services provided by local mobile operators. Pre-paid SIM cards supporting 3G, 4G or 5G mobile services provided by them are widely available in Hong Kong<sup>1</sup>. Apart from getting online through local mobile operators, you can also enjoy public free Wi-Fi Internet access at designated government premises such as public libraries and sports venues. To connect to the government Wi-Fi services, you need a compatible Wi-Fi device or smartphone with Wi-Fi function. No user registration is required for using free Wi-Fi services. Many private premises such as restaurants, cafes and shopping malls also offer free Wi-Fi services to shoppers and customers but they may require user registration or password.

## International calls

International calls can be made from Hong Kong to most countries and regions of the world; and most cities and towns in Mainland China. You may use international direct dialling (IDD) service for calling from Hong Kong and calling back to Hong Kong from overseas.

Furthermore, all mobile operators in Hong Kong offer international roaming service. Before you come to Hong Kong, you can subscribe to international roaming service offered by operators in your home country (and check if they have roaming partners in Hong Kong). You may then make local and international calls in Hong Kong using your mobile phone. This service is subject to roaming charges of the operator in your home country.

You may also choose to purchase an international calling card for making calls from Hong Kong to other countries (including your home country). This type of calling card is commonly available at retail shops of local mobile operators and convenience stores.

In addition to making calls by any fixed line phone or mobile phone, you can use coins, calling cards or credit cards on a payphone.
