I can't wait to take the challenge." a participant said.

The participants were encouraged to complete the obstacle courses and some obstacles required players to cooperate with each other to proceed to the next course. Participants from different ethnicity broke the ice and helped each other get through different level of obstacle courses. Some participants happily shared that they overcame their fear by trying an over 10-meter-high water slide with the encouragement from peers. "As a person with fear of heights, I never thought I would be able to challenge myself by trying out the tallest water slide in the park." a participant said.

Participants enrolled in the Water Adventure Day through the eight Support Service Centres for Ethnic Minorities which are commissioned by the Home Affairs Department to provide various support services to help ethnic minorities integrate into the community.
