



## Home Affairs Department's Support Service Centres for Ethnic Minorities

Various government bureaux and departments have been providing various services to help ethnic minorities integrate into the society as early as possible. Home Affairs Department (HAD) makes use of the district network of District Offices and through non-profit-making organisations and district organisations to provide support services for ethnic minorities.

## Support Service Centres for Ethnic Minorities

There are six support service centres and two sub-centres for ethnic minorities in Hong Kong, offering tailor made classes, counselling, integration programmes and employment services to help them integrate into the community. Youth Units in these centres provide sports and music programmes, and other dedicated activities for ethnic minority youth. The CHEER Centre also provides telephone interpretation service and translation service to assist ethnic minorities in their use of public services.
